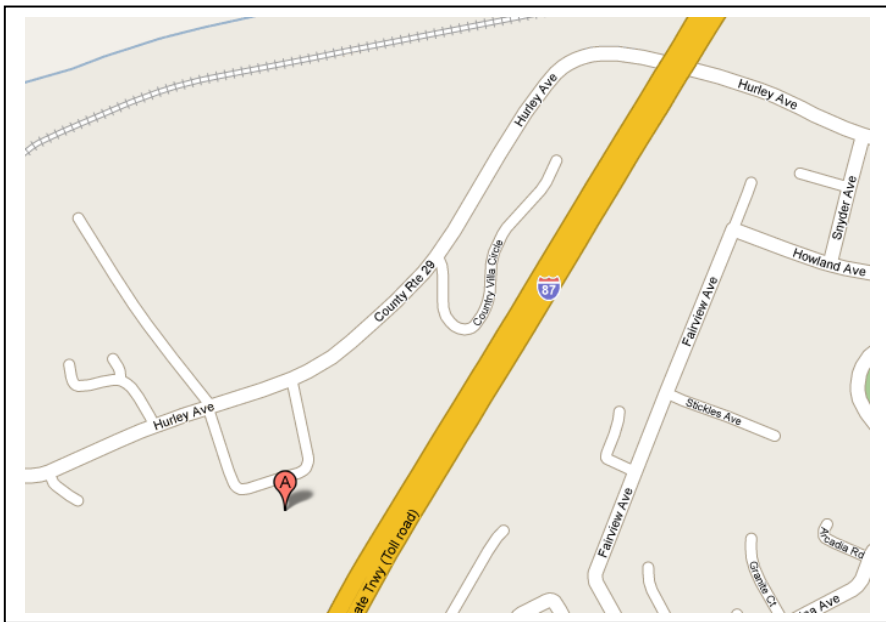

From Kingston/Rhinecliff Bridge:

- Take 199/209S to Sawkill Road
- Take Sawkill Road to Washington Avenue
- At light, turn left onto Washington Avenue
- Turn right onto Hurley Avenue
- Take Hurley Avenue 1.5 miles to John A. Coleman High School

From the NYS Thruway:

- Take Exit 19 into Kingston
- Exit to Washington Avenue from the Roundabout
- Turn right at the second traffic light onto Hurley Avenue
- Take Hurley Avenue 1.5 miles to John A. Coleman High School

From Route 32 South:

- Take Route 32 into Kingston
- Turn left at flashing light onto Washington Avenue
- After one flashing traffic light and six traffic lights, turn left onto Hurley Avenue
- Take Hurley Avenue 1.5 miles to John A. Coleman High School

From Route 9W South:

- Take Route 9W North through Port Ewen
- Follow arterial to Route 32 (T-intersection)
- Turn right, and go under over-pass
- Take Route 209S
- Follow directions from Kingston/Rhinecliff Bridge
