It's about a 40 minute drive going on Route 44 East then to the Salt Point Turnpike (Route 115) then to the Taconic State Parkway then go north to Route 199 interchange Turn left toward Red Hook which is West on Route 199 for about 4/10 miles Turn right onto Tribune Lane Continue onto White Drive

From Red Hook Route 9 & 199

7.2 Miles on Route 199 Turn right onto Tribune Lane Continue onto White Drive

From Kingston-Rhinecliff Bridge

13 Miles on Route 199 Turn right onto Tribune Lane Continue onto White Drive

From Hyde Park

E Market St and NY-9G

Take 9G North 11 Miles, Right on NY-308 E 4.2 Miles Merge on NY-199 E 3.2 Miles Turn right onto Tribune Lane Continue onto White Drive
